Parental Obligations

Thank you for your participation in Peppermill Village Boys and Girls Basketball season. The principles of supporting schools have graciously allowed us to utilize this facility for our home games and practices. To ensure our continued usage we must behave as one unit and participate in its general upkeep. Together we must oversee the behavior of our youth and ensure a safe, supportive and respectful environment for each of our players. Disturbances of any type could jeopardize the continuation of this program in these facilities. Please adhere to the following rules and regulations while assisting our coaching staff:



Basketball practices are closed sessions, intended for players only. Parents are welcome to stay; however, other children should be left at home. If siblings accompany the parent to the practice they should not be allowed to run around inside or outside of the gym area. **DO NOT** leave siblings unattended as they become restless and run around unsupervised.



Do not allow players to bring balls from home. Those who do, often disturb the practice session. Players should not be on the court until their scheduled practice hour or scheduled game.



Parents should always accompany their child to the rest rooms which are located outside the gym in the hallway.



Parents who leave their players at practice or games **MUST** pick them up on time following the conclusion of each activity.
