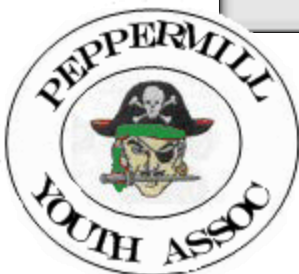

PEPPERMILL YOUTH ASSOCIATION POLICY LETTER

Dear Parents and Participants:

Welcome to the 2011 tackle football season! I hope you are as excited as I am and are ready to have fun and make this a successful season. To those of you that have participated before *"WELCOME BACK"* and to those of you that are joining us for the first time, *"THANK YOU"* for choosing Peppermill.

It is always our goal to teach your child the fundamentals, challenges and competitiveness of football while having fun doing so. The skills associated with working along with others is an invaluable resource and highly important for social development. It is my desire that the experiences gained from this program are memorable tools that can be applied in life to help them become a better person.

We understand that kids learn and develop at different paces. To help them in this process we have a three tier playing system: Developmental teams and level one and level two competition teams.

DEVELOPMENTAL TEAMS

All participants at the Mitey Mite level play at the non-competition developmental level. The emphasis is placed on team work and skill development as opposed to competition. This allows the child to develop and learn skills at a modified pace. No scores are kept and there are no defined winners or losers. The games are played on a smaller playing field with modified rules. They still get the same team experiences without the added pressure of having to be "the best".

COMPETITION TEAMS

The Cubs, Anklebiters, Ponys, Midgets, Juniors and Intermediates are the competitive teams. When participation is high for any weight class at this level, two or more teams are formed. Every player is given an opportunity to display their skills to determine level of play. The final decision of placement is strictly the responsibility of the head coaches and their respective staffs. Regardless of skills placement, players are equally recognized for their participation with a chance at a playoff. Also at the end of the season the organization has a recognition program and trophies are given to all participants regardless of playing level.

I recognize that your view of your child's skills level doesn't always align with the coaches' views. However, I would hope that you would support our efforts to continue our competitive tradition and maintain our "family values" environment. Be positive, supportive and encouraging throughout the year. If this becomes impossible, I would suggest that you consult with me as to whether your child should remain a part of our program. Rude behavior and negativity will not be tolerated.

This letter and subsequent rules provided to you and your child is in no way meant to be a heavyweight hanging over your head. We feel it is important to notify you of our rules; and that they must be adhered to. We feel that everyone should act more responsible and maintain a shared responsible environment especially when they know the parameters involved or where they stand. We also realize that extreme situations can arise and we may have to alter a rule if deemed necessary, but ONLY if it is in the best interest of the individual and program.

Again, WELCOME ABOARD! I am so excited to “get the ball rollin” and watch this group of talented young athletes grow and mature; and put their own footprints in the PEPPERMILL PIRATES history books.

Parents Code of Ethics

1. Give constructive criticism and or voice your concerns during a private moment, never in front of other parents, players, your child, officials, spectators, etc.
2. Support your child, but refrain from excessive "sideline coaching". Yell words of encouragement.
3. Support your coach. Always cheer your child on but leave the "coaching" to the team coaches.
4. Refrain from interfering with the process of team assignment or position assignment for your child.
5. Accept the decisions of officials on the field as being fair and called to the best of their ability. If questions regarding the game arise, leave it in the hands of the coaches.
6. Remain off the playing field at all times; during practices as well as games.
7. Do not criticize an opposing coach, team, or team fans by words or gestures. The actions are grounds for immediate removal from the playing site as well as permanent disbarment.
8. Parents will not encourage their child or any other person to engage in un-sportsmanship like conduct with any coach, parent player, participant, officials or any other attendees.
9. Ensure that your child in on time for all practice sessions and games. Unexcused absence my lead to reduced game time or expulsion from the team
